- Through ongoing implementation, use an EHS management system approach to establish goals, implement programs, evaluate progress, and continually improve performance;

- Promote environmental responsibility through training to ensure employees are competent to perform their assignments effectively and safely;
- Maintain a state of readiness for effective spill and incident response to minimize potential threats to public safety and the environment;
